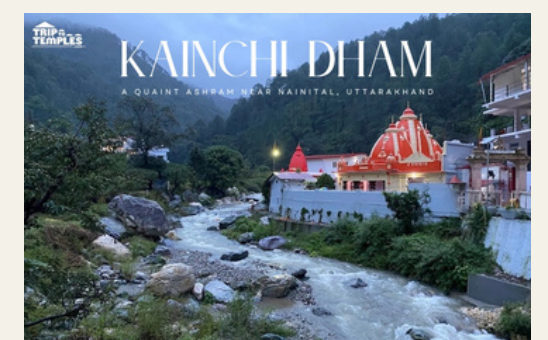
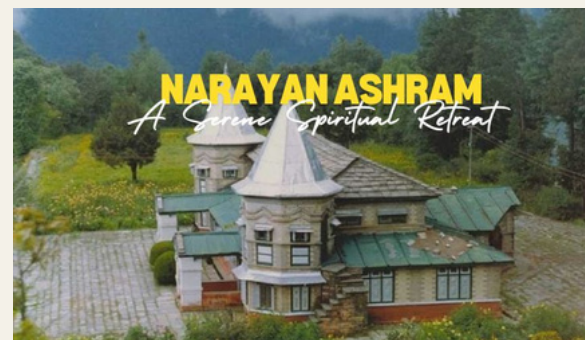
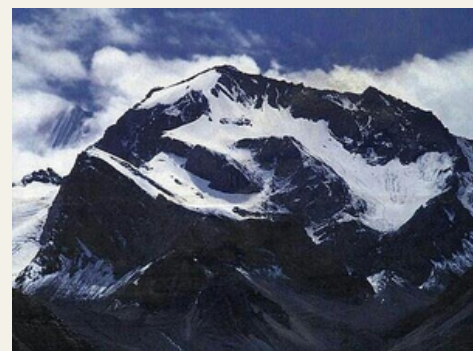

# AADI KAILASH

## JYOLINGKONG

Adi Kailash (Kumaoni: आदि कैलाश), also known as Shiva Kailash, Chota Kailash, Baba Kailash or Jonglingkong Peak, is a mountain located in the Himalayan mountain range in the Pithoragarh district of Uttarakhand, India's<sup>1</sup> It is the second most important peak among the group of five separate peaks in Himalayas in separate locations collectively known as the Panch Kailash or "Five Kailashas", others being Mount Kailash in the first place, Shikhar Kailash (Shrikhand Mahadev Kailash) in the third, Kinnaur Kailash in the fourth and Manimahesh Kailash in the fifth place in terms of importance. Gauri Kund (Jolingkong Lake) and Parvati Tal glacial lakes are at the base of the Adi Parvat



Adi Kailash and Limpiyadhura Pass (further northwest of Adi Kailash) are both located northwest of Gunji. The Lipulekh Pass, Old Lipulekh Peak, and Om Parvat (southwest of Lipulekh Pass) are located northeast of Gunji. Adi Kailash base camp, near the Hindu Shiva temple on the banks of sacred Jolingkong Lake (Gauri Kund), is located 17 km northwest of Kuthi (Kuti) village in Kuthi Yankti Valley (Kuthi or Kuti Valley)

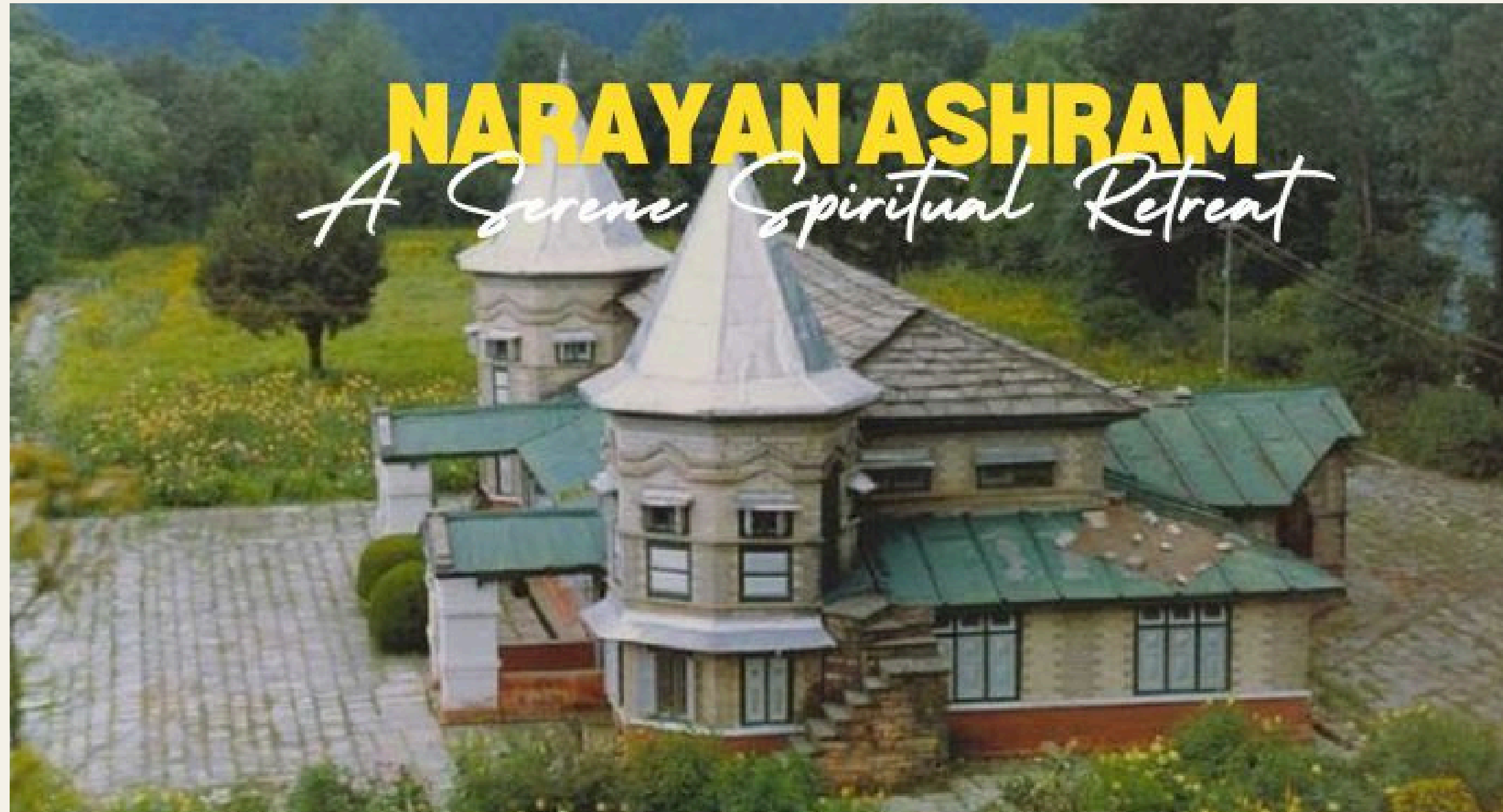

# NARAYAN ASHRAM

## CHAUDAS VALLEY

Narayan Ashram is a spiritual and socio-educational center located in Dharchula, Pithoragarh district, Uttarakhand, India. Established by Narayan Swami in 1936, it is situated at an elevation of 2734 meters, nestled amidst Deodar forests and scenic landscapes. The ashram serves as a place for spiritual practices, education for local children and youth, and offers a library, meditation room, and a samadhi sthal (a place of remembrance).





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# CHITAI GOLU DEVTA

ALMORA

Golu Devta is famously regarded as God of Justice. Maximum devotees worship the deity and ask for the justice on behalf of the injustice have been done to them or with their family.

Devotees worship at Golu Devta with the means of White cloth, Pagri and White Shawl. People believes that God asks for in propitiation is a bell, as is evident from the thousands of bells strung across the temple premises.

Anyone can even seek Gollu Devtas divine intervention by writing to him. Stacks of letter are pinned all over the temple along with bells



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# PATAL BHUBNESHWAR

GANGOLIHAAT

Patal Bhuvaneshwar (Hindi : पाताल भुवनेश्वर) is a limestone Hindu cave temple 14 km from Gangolihat in the Pithoragarh district of Uttarakhand state in India. It is located in the village of Bhubneshwar. Legend and folklore have it that this cave enshrines Lord Shiva and thirty three koti demigods [33 Types, In hindu neumerology "Koti" means "Types"]. The cave is 160 m long and 90 feet deep from the point of entrance.



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# JAGESHWAR DHAM

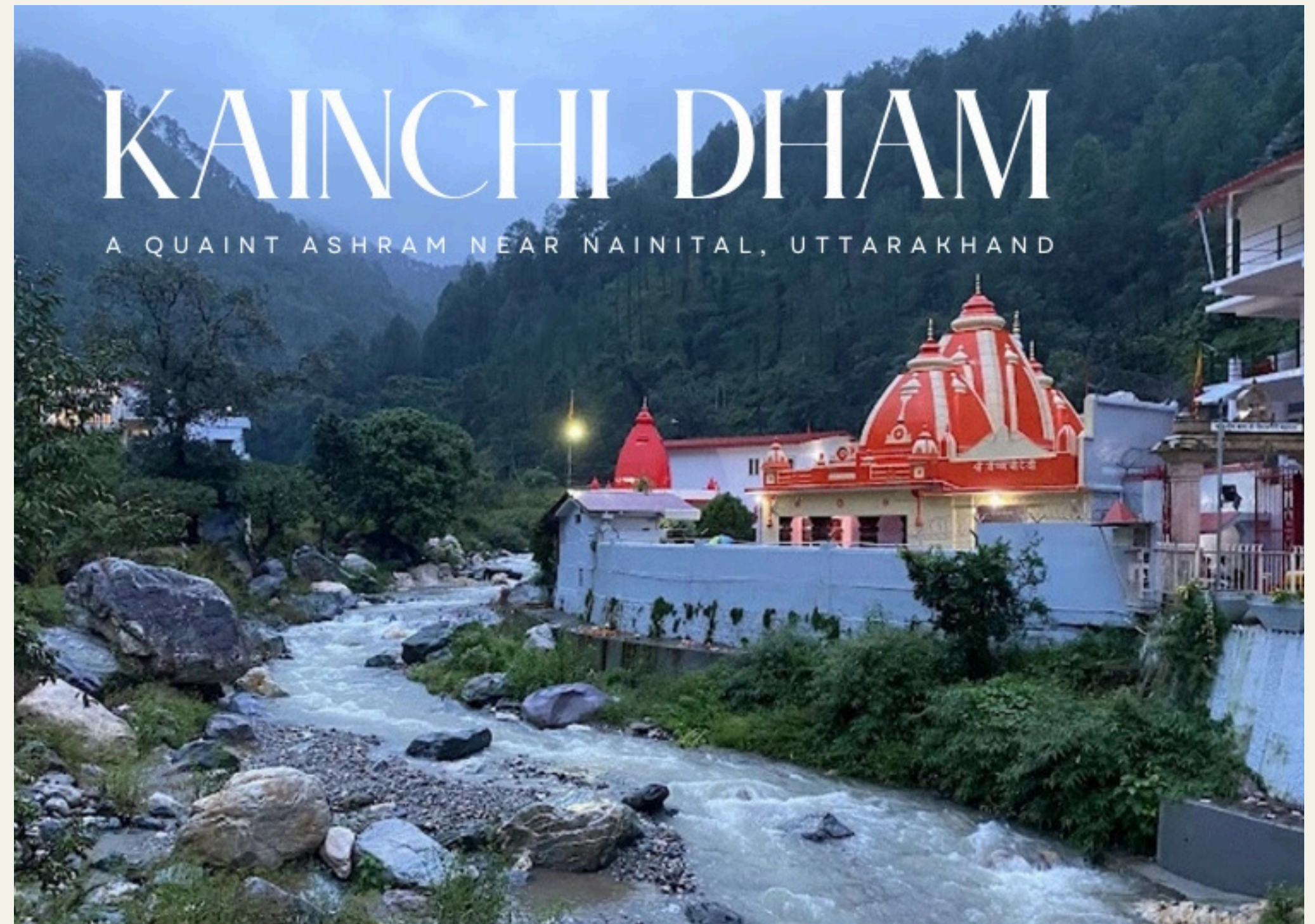
ALMORA

One of the finest examples of architecture in Uttarakhand, Jageshwar Dham is a group of temples dedicated to Lord Shiva. There are 124 big and small temples that look simply beautiful with a gorgeous backdrop of rolling green mountains and a gurgling Jata Ganga stream. As per ASI (Archaeology Survey of India), the temple dates back to post Gupta and pre-medieval era and said to be 2500 years old. Stone lingams, stone sculptures and carving on altars are the highlight of the temple. The temple's location is ideal for meditation as well..

# KAINCHI DHAM

## NAINITAL

Kainchi Dham, set in Nainital, Uttarakhand is a spiritual retreat with an aura of serenity and devotion. The place was set up by Neem Karoli Baba, a spiritual guru. Today it has become a place of pilgrimage and meditation. The temple, dedicated to Neem Karoli Baba, attracts seekers and devotees from all corners, offering solace.



# NAINITAL LAKE

## NAINITAL

Naini Tal, also known as Naini Lake, is a natural freshwater body, situated amidst the town of Nainital in Kumaon, Uttarakhand, India. It is tectonic in origin and was almost circular, until frequent landslides made it crescent shaped and has an outfall at the southeastern end.<sup>[1][2]</sup> Nainital, along with other lakes of Kumaon, is integral to tourism and recreation in Kumaon. The lake is also an integral part of Kumaoni folklore.



# KASAR DEVI

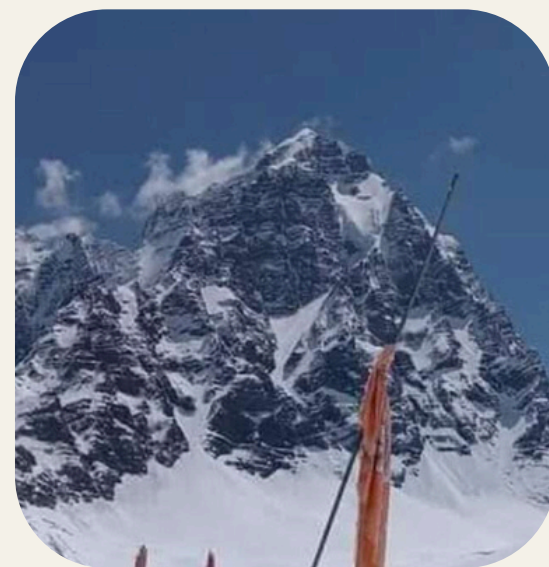
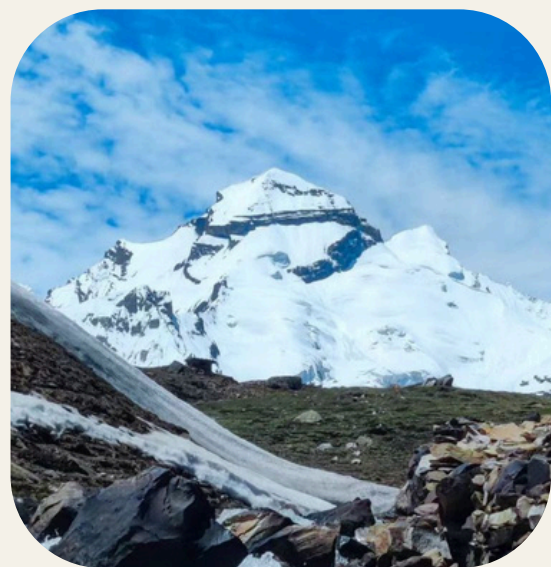
ALMORA

Kasar Devi is a village near Almora, Uttarakhand. It is known for the Kasar Devi temple, a Devi temple, dedicated to Kasar Devi, after whom the place is also named. The temple structure dates to the 2nd century CE. Swami Vivekananda visited Kasar Devi in 1890s, and numerous western seeker, Sunyata Baba Alfred Sorensen and Lama Anagarika Govinda.
